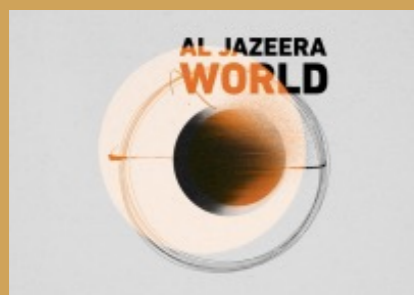

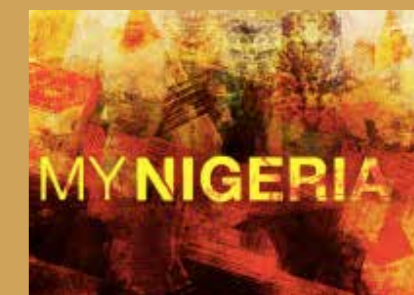

**RTS Journalism Award for Breaking News**

Al Jazeera English's news team earned a 2021 Royal Television Society's award for Breaking News for its coverage of the Beirut blast in August 2020, commended by the judges as a "journalistic tour de force".

**AIB Channel of the Year**

Al Jazeera English was named Channel of the Year by the Association of International Broadcasters in 2021, with the judges praising the work of the teams on the field and the stream of visuals from around the world.

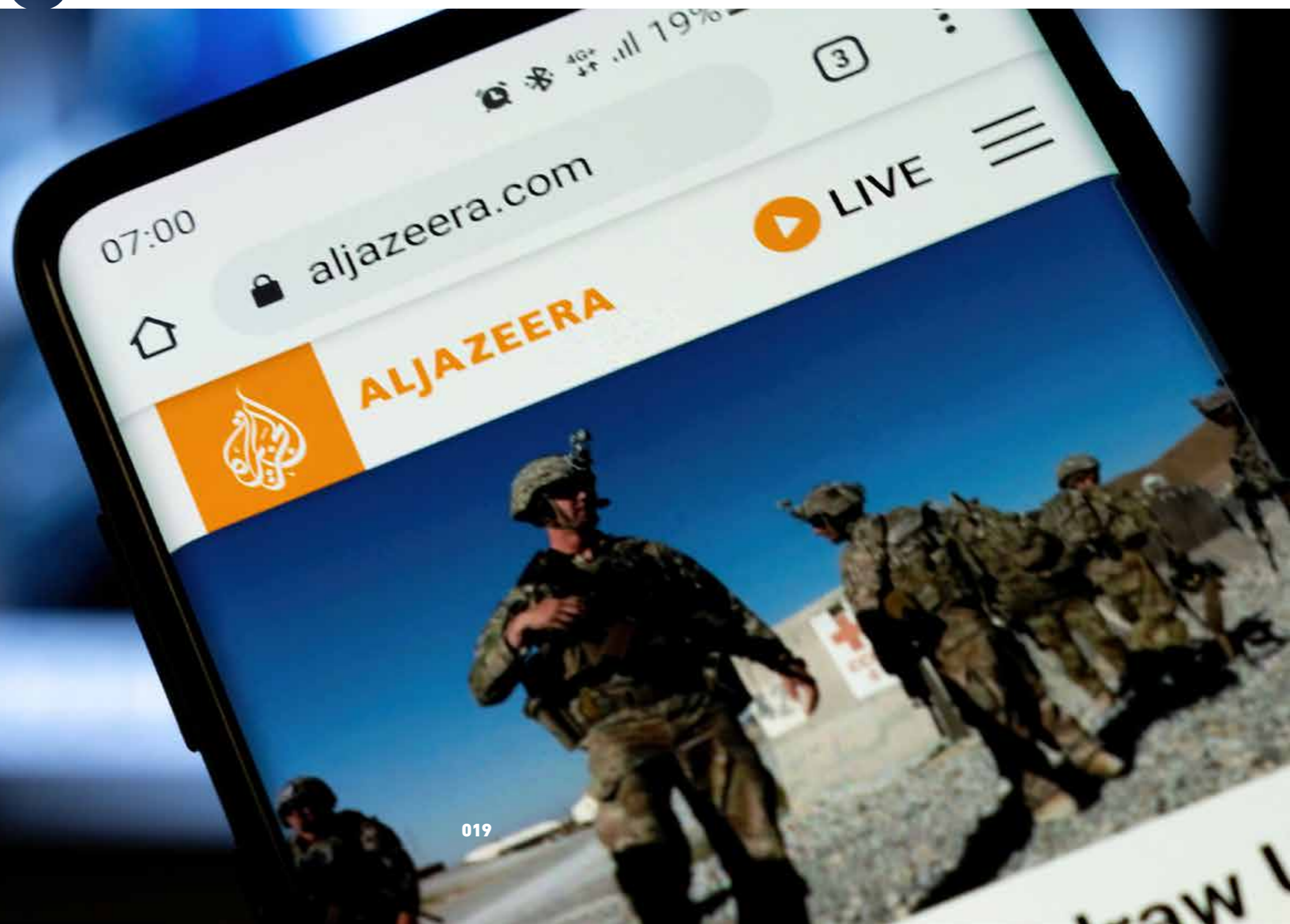
